

STALLION BREEDING AGREEMENT

***OLIVERO • Shagya-Arabian Stallion • 2026 Breeding Season**

Cooled Shipped Semen • Live Foal Guarantee with Right of Return

1. PARTIES TO THIS AGREEMENT

This Stallion Breeding Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between:

1. A copy of the Mare's pedigree (at minimum four generations, front and back of registration papers if applicable).
2. Documentation of all current breeding approvals held by the Mare, including inspection scores, studbook acceptance, and the name of the approving registry or registries. If the Mare has not been presented for inspection, Mare Owner must state this in writing.

4. BREEDING FEES AND PAYMENT

(a) The Booking Fee of \$250.00 is non-refundable and reserves a breeding for the Mare in *Olivero's 2026 season. This Agreement is not binding until the signed Agreement and Booking Fee are received by Stallion Owner.

(b) No Collection Fee is charged. Stallion Owner covers all costs of semen collection.

(c) Shipping costs are billed via FedEx at actual cost. See Section 5 for full shipping and container return details.

(d) The Stud Fee of \$1,000.00 is payable upon confirmed live foal, defined as a foal that stands and nurses for a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours following birth (see Section 6). No Breeder's Certificate will be issued until all fees are paid in full.

(e) Payment is accepted exclusively via PayPal or Venmo. No checks, cash, wire transfers, or other forms of payment are accepted. All fees must be current and payment confirmed before semen is shipped. Outstanding balances accrue interest at 1.5% per month after thirty (30) days.

5. SEMEN SHIPMENT AND BREEDING PROCEDURES

(a) *Olivero is available for cooled semen collection Monday through Friday during the 2026 breeding season (April 1 – September 30, 2026). Collection is not available on major federal holidays.

(b) Mare Owner or Mare Owner's veterinarian must contact Annorien Sporthorses a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the requested collection and shipping date. Requests received with less than 48 hours notice cannot be guaranteed and will be accommodated only at Stallion Owner's discretion.

(c) Semen is shipped via FedEx Priority Overnight using an appropriate insulated semen cooling container. Shipping costs are charged at actual FedEx rates. Mare Owner may elect to provide their own FedEx account number to be billed directly; in that case, no shipping charge will appear on the Annorien Sporthorses invoice. If no FedEx account number is provided, actual shipping costs will be invoiced to Mare Owner and must be

paid prior to shipment. Mare Owner is responsible for prompt return of any shipping containers as specified on the container documentation; a replacement fee of up to \$300.00 may be assessed for containers not returned within five (5) business days.

(c) Semen provided under this Agreement may only be used to breed the Mare identified herein. Semen may not be frozen for future use, transferred to a third party, used for ICSI, or used to breed any mare other than the named Mare without prior written authorization from Stallion Owner. Any unauthorized use results in forfeiture of all fees paid and termination of this Agreement.

(d) If a Mare fails to settle after two (2) shipments, Stallion Owner reserves the right to request a current uterine culture, cytology, and reproductive examination before shipping additional doses. Results must be provided in writing before further shipment.

(e) Mare Owner is responsible for ensuring that their veterinarian is licensed, experienced in equine artificial insemination, and properly equipped to perform the insemination.

6. LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE AND RIGHT OF RETURN

Live Foal Guarantee

Mare Owner is guaranteed one (1) "live foal," defined as a foal that stands and nurses for a minimum of twenty-four (24) consecutive hours following birth. This guarantee applies to one foal from one mare in the contracted breeding season.

Conditions Triggering Right of Return

If the Mare proves barren at the end of the breeding season, aborts the pregnancy, delivers a stillborn foal, or the foal fails to stand and nurse for twenty-four (24) hours, Mare Owner is entitled to a complimentary return breeding to *Olivero (or, at Stallion Owner's sole discretion, a stallion of comparable breeding value) in the immediately following season (2027), subject to the following conditions:

3. Mare Owner must provide written notification of the qualifying event (barren, abortion, stillbirth, or foal failure) to Stallion Owner within thirty (30) days of the event, along with a veterinary certificate documenting the outcome.
4. The right of return applies to the named Mare only and is non-transferable. If the Mare is sold or becomes permanently unfit for breeding, the right of return is void and no refund will be issued.
5. The return breeding season covers one additional season only. There is no further guarantee beyond the single return season.
6. Shipping costs and any associated veterinary expenses during the return season are the sole responsibility of Mare Owner.
7. The right of return is valid only if all fees from the original breeding contract have been paid in full.
8. Should multiple embryos or foals result from a single breeding, each additional live foal incurs an additional Stud Fee of \$1,000.00 due within thirty (30) days of confirmation. The Live Foal Guarantee applies only to the first live foal.

Mare Owner Responsibilities to Protect LFG

To maintain eligibility for the Live Foal Guarantee, Mare Owner is strongly encouraged to: (a) administer equine herpesvirus (Pneumabort-K or equivalent) vaccination during the 5th, 7th, and 9th months of

gestation; (b) avoid fescue grass and hay for at least ninety (90) days prior to the anticipated foaling date; (c) deworm the mare on a regular schedule throughout gestation; (d) provide adequate nutrition, shelter, and veterinary oversight; and (e) notify Stallion Owner immediately of any pregnancy complications. Failure to follow reasonable husbandry practices may, at Stallion Owner's discretion, affect eligibility for the right of return.

7. SUBSTITUTION OF MARE OR STALLION

(a) Mare Substitution: If the named Mare becomes permanently unfit to breed, dies, or is sold during the contract period, Mare Owner may request in writing that a substitute mare be allowed. Approval of any substitution is at the sole discretion of Stallion Owner. The Booking Fee is non-refundable in any circumstance. No Live Foal Guarantee transfers to a substitute mare unless expressly agreed upon in writing.

(b) Stallion Unavailability: If *Olivero dies, becomes infirm, or is otherwise rendered permanently unfit for collection prior to settling the named Mare, this Agreement shall terminate and the Stud Fee balance (if pre-paid) will be refunded to Mare Owner. The Booking Fee is non-refundable. Frozen semen, if available, may be offered as an alternative at Stallion Owner's discretion. Stallion Owner's sole liability in the event of stallion unavailability shall be limited to refund of the pre-paid Stud Fee balance.

8. BREEDER'S CERTIFICATE AND REGISTRY

Stallion Owner will execute and provide a Breeder's Certificate upon: (a) confirmation of a live foal as defined in Section 6; (b) receipt of a completed Mare Breeding Report signed by the attending veterinarian documenting the breeding date(s), method, ovulation, and pregnancy confirmation; and (c) payment in full of all fees due under this Agreement.

Mare Owner is solely responsible for understanding and satisfying any registry requirements for the Mare and any resulting foal, including but not limited to NASS, ISG, Trakehner Association of North America (TANA), or any other breed society. Stallion Owner makes no representation regarding foal eligibility for registration with any specific registry.

9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND WARRANTIES

(a) Stallion Owner warrants that *Olivero is a licensed breeding stallion in sound reproductive health as of the date of this Agreement. No warranty is made regarding the genetic outcome, color, height, conformation, or athletic ability of any resulting foal.

(b) Stallion Owner's liability under this Agreement is strictly limited to: (i) refund of the pre-paid Stud Fee balance if the stallion becomes permanently unavailable before settling the Mare (Section 7(b)); and (ii) one complimentary return season as provided under the Live Foal Guarantee (Section 6). In no event shall Stallion Owner be liable for consequential, incidental, or indirect damages of any kind.

(c) Mare Owner assumes all risks associated with the Mare's reproductive health, veterinary care, and the inherent risks of equine reproduction. Mare Owner is urged to obtain appropriate mortality and reproductive failure insurance on the Mare prior to breeding.

(d) This Agreement is non-assignable and non-transferable by either party without prior written consent of the other party.

(e) This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding the breeding of the named Mare to *Olivero. It supersedes all prior conversations, representations, or understandings. Amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.

(f) This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Michigan. Any disputes shall be resolved in the courts of Washtenaw County, Michigan.

10. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND SIGNATURES

By signing below, both parties agree to be bound by all terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. Mare Owner acknowledges having read and understood this Agreement in its entirety.
